## Instructions for Use

## Single Patient Use

Warning Do not use directly on broken skin.

Before removing the backing from the adhesive, apply the splint to the nose to determine the ideal size and position for the splint. **Figure 1.** 

Remove the backing from the adhesive. Figure 2.

Clean the skin, and when dry, apply the splint to the nose. **Figure 3.** 

The splint can be removed and reapplied to adjust its position if required.

To reduce the grip, position the splint a little higher on the nose (toward the eyes). **Figure 4.** 

To increase the grip, position the splint a little lower on the nose (toward the nostrils). **Figure 5.** 

The nostrils can be protected or not depending on the indication.

The splint can be forced open a few times to reduce the grip, if it is too tight. **Figure 6.** 

A self-adhesive Dorsal pad can be used under the splint to compress the Nasal Dorsum if needed.
